VIDEO/AUDIO/MULTIMEDIA APPROVAL

The principal/designee shall review and pre-approve all video/audio programs in any format from any source other than the District's subscription digital multimedia resource before they are shown to students in the classroom or at a school-related activity on or off campus.

- 1. Any video/audio/multimedia recording must be used during face-to-face teaching and link directly to the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills objectives of the current lesson with notation in the lesson plans. The teacher shall include in the lesson plans: pre-activities and post-activities to strengthen the impact of the video/audio/multimedia.
2. Board policy strictly prohibits any film rated "R" or "X."
3. If it is rated PG-13, the film must be specifically referenced in the curriculum and parent permission is required.
4. Videos available in the Library/Resource Center must be pre-approved; the teacher shall include those videos/audios/multimedia recordings in the lesson plans and use such media with prudence.
5. A 48 hour prior notice for campus principal/designee approval is required.
